Grow Oregano In A Pot

Quick Checklist - Grow Oregano In A Pot

Pick a variety you would like to grow.

- Greek
- Italian
- Mexican
- Common
- Cuban

Buy the required items from your local garden center or online.

- Oregano Seeds
- Potting mix
- Pot (10-inches H x 18-inches W)
- Slow-release fertilizer
- Liquid fertilizer

Pick a season to grow oregano, either spring or fall.

Mix the slow-release fertilizer with the potting mix.

Fill the potting mix into the pot till 1 inch from the rim.

Place several seeds in the soil at a slight distance from each other.

Press the seeds lightly on top of the soil as they need sunlight to germinate.

Grow Oregano In A Pot

Spray water to keep the potting mix moist till seeds germinate.

Place the pot in a location that gets 6-8 hours of indirect sunlight.

Every day check the moisture by sticking your finger 1 inch into the soil.

Water the soil well if it has turned dry.

Thin the seedlings if there are too many in the pot.

Add liquid fertilizer to the soil every two weeks.

Harvest oregano when the plant grows 4-6 inches.
