Quick Checklist - Grow Tomatoes In A Pot

Pick a determinate tomato variety you would like to grow.

- Celebrity
- Roma
- Fresh Salsa
- Bushsteak
- Supertasty

Buy the required items from your local garden center or online.

- Tomato seeds or seedlings
- Potting mix
- 5/10/15/20 Gallon Pot
- Slow-release fertilizer
- · Liquid fertilizer

Pick a season to grow tomatoes, late spring or early summer.

Mix the slow-release fertilizer with the potting mix.

Fill the potting mix into the pot till 1 inch from the rim.

Place several seeds in the soil at a slight distance from each other.

Cover the seeds with 1/4-inch of potting mix.

Grow Tomatoes In A Pot

Spray water to keep the potting mix moist till seeds germinate.

Place the pot in a location that gets 6-8 hours of indirect sunlight.

Every day check the moisture by sticking your finger 1 inch into the soil.

Water the soil well if it has turned dry.

Thin the seedlings if there are too many in the pot.

Support the tomato plant with staking or caging.

Add liquid fertilizer to the soil every two weeks.

Add organic mulch to the tomato plant.

Prune the unwanted suckers of the tomato plant.

Harvest tomatoes when the plant matures after 60-70 days.
